Services: Camp Big Sky is available to any person of any age with any disability that limits or restricts their access to the outdoors. The camp is staffed by a fully trained and enthusiastic team to assure a safe and enjoyable visit for all. Friends, family and caregivers are welcome to share the experience.

Cost/Availability: You may come for the day or weekend. All food and water, etc. needs to be transported to the camp. You must call for availability. Overnight visits will have a \$50.00 fee.

Facilities/Amenities: Wheelchair accessible fishing piers on two lakes, floating dock and two wheelchair accessible boats; platform tent sleeps four to six with a ramp and wrap-around porch; cabin sleeping for four, 100-acres of wetlands, timber, trees, flowers, grassland pastures, and lakes with wheelchair accessible ramps and trail ways; Special Olympics regulation bocce ball court; port-a-potties and changing stations.
